2014 MCA HALL OF FAME

The Montana Coaches Association is pleased to announce the induction of three members into the MCA Hall of Fame. Their prestigious awards will be presented at the 11:30 Awards Ceremony on Thursday, July 31st in the Great Falls High School Auditorium, in conjunction with the MCA All-Sports Coaches Clinic. Family and friends are invited. All attendees will be served a complimentary luncheon in the cafeteria immediately after the ceremony. Congratulations to these outstanding coaches and fine gentlemen!

Clayton Hornung - Baker

Clayton has coached for 37 years In Montana, 7 of those years at Turner and the last 30 at Baker High School. Coach Hornung's teams won an impressive 468 games at Baker. He led the lady Spartans to 5 divisional championships, qualifying for the state tournament 11 times. They played in the Chipper 5 times, with 3 championships. They also tallied two thirds and a fourth place finish.

A 35 year member of the MCA, Coach Hornung was Coach of the Year 3 times and has been a nominee 8 times. He has coached the B East Team at the Treasures State Classic for 17 years and was a nominee for National COY.

Richy Powell - Dawson County (Glendive)

Richy has coached high school basketball for 30 years, 22 of those years at Dawson County. During his tenure, his girls' teams have accumulated 327 wins and his boys' teams, 106, for an impressive 433 career wins. While serving as head mentor for the lady Red Devils, his teams qualified for the State Tournament 7 times, playing for the Championship 3 times coupled with 2 thirds, a fourth and one fifth place finish.

Coach Powell has led the Eastern A team Treasure State Classic Team 15 times and received the MHSA "Distinguished Service Award" for his involvement in the "Aim Higher" program. Coaching stints at Plenty Coups, Joliet, Clyde Park and Highwood initiated his 32 year MCA membership. He has also served 3 years as an MCA board member. Most recently, Richy has served as Assistant Women's Coach for Dawson Community College.

Doug Robison - Billings West

Doug's basketball coaching record at Billings West is unparalleled, with a cumulative record of 356-110, giving him more wins than any coach in Billings prep boys' basketball history. Doug just completed his 20th season at West. Overall in 20 years at West High, his Bears have qualified for the State Tournament 19 times, placing in the top three on 12 occasions and winning 3 state championships along the way. 6 second place finishes and 3 thirds were also garnered. They played in 6 straight AA Championship games which is unprecedented in Montana basketball history.

Coach Robison opened his 28 year coaching career at Geyser followed by Missoula Loyola before settling at West. After 10 years at West he took a five year coaching sabbatical to serve as AD before jumping back to the helm of the Golden Bears.
