COACH OF THE YEAR RINGS

We hope that all rings for the 2012-2013 first-time Coaches of the Year can be presented at the Clinic Awards Ceremony. Fall & Winter sports COY orders should be in by now.

In order to meet the deadline for clinic presentation, we need the cooperation of the recipients. As soon as coaches find out they were elected COY the first time, they should immediately go to a jeweler and find out their ring size. The timing for spring sports recipients will be so tight, that I will phone you as soon as the ballots have been counted and ask you to go to http://montanacoaches.com/, print the order form and send it to Balfour immediately. It is imperative that you return the order form as soon as possible to insure delivery in time for the clinic. Orders take 6 weeks to Process.

Richard Martinez of Balfour plans to exhibit at the clinic again. They will also have some good items for exhibit and/or door prizes and are donating 10 dozen Titleist golf balls for tourney prizes. Coaches who have previously won a ring, may wish to purchase another. They are as inexpensive as \$110, and are available in a gold tone at that price. LIABILITY INSURANCE

Our regular members are covered by a million dollar liability program through our affiliation with NOCAD. See the back of your 2012-13 membership card for insurance contact. This includes camp coverage and classroom coverage for active members who are working in athletic programs and also teaching. Associate members are not covered in the classroom but can be covered while working a camp. Please inform us if you are an associate member working a camp. Members putting on camps may also purchase accident insurance for participants and "Additional Insured" coverage, if required for using school facilities. If you need a certificate of insurance showing you are covered, go online to: loomislapann.com, click on sports insurance, then click on NOCAD-sports coverage to obtain proof of insurance. Our fiscal year ends May 31st, but our insurance coverage runs from Aug 1st through July 31st, so anyone working a camp this summer, who wants the insurance coverage, needs to be a 2012-13 member. Please inform non-member coaches, who may be working with you in camps, about that requirement. They may still pay dues for 2012-13 to be covered.
