# **LIABILITY INSURANCE**

In this day and age Liability Insurance is a must! What a great deal MCA active members have, being covered by a million dollar liability policy through our affiliation with NOCAD! (See the back of your membership card for insurance contact info). This coverge is not only during your sport season but also for camps, plus classroom coverage for active members who are both coach and teacher. Retired members do not have insurance, but can be covered while working a camp if you notify the MCA office in advance. For insurance questions, please contact Loomis and LaPann at 800-566-6479. Members putting on camps may also purchase accident insurance for participants and "Additional Insured" coverage, if required for using school facilities. If you need a certificate of insurance showing you are covered, go online to: loomislapann.com, click on "Coaches Associations", then scroll down and click on "Liability Coverage" to obtain proof of insurance. Our fiscal year ends May 31st, but our insurance coverage runs from Aug 1st through July 31st, so anyone working a camp in June or July, who wants the liability coverage, needs to be a 2014-15 member. Please inform non-member coaches, who may be working camps with you, about this requirement. They may still pay dues for 2014-15 to be covered in June and July.

## **LONGEVITY**

Longevity Awards are given to member MCA coaches beginning with 15 and 20 years. These folks receive a certificate but can upgrade to a plaque for \$13. Starting at 25 years and at each 5-year mark thereafter, MCA provides a plaques for Longevity recipients.
