# Youth Suicide Statistical Impact

#### According to the latest CDC's WISQARS National Data Reporting (2020):



- Suicide is the 2<sup>nd</sup> leading cause of death for ages 10-14 in Montana.
- Suicide is the 2<sup>nd</sup> leading cause of death for ages 12-18 (middle and high school ages) in Montana.
- Suicide is the 2<sup>nd</sup> leading cause of death for college-age youth ages 18-22 in Montana.

#### <u>Montana 2021 Youth Risk Behavioral Survey (CDC): (Most Recent Released</u> <u>Report)</u>

### When young people were asked in Montana:

"Have you experienced the feeling of hopelessness and sadness for a constant period of two weeks or greater during the past twelve months (possible beginning of clinical depression)?"

41.4% answered YES or almost 1 out of every 3 young people. Compared to Nationally – 42.3% (depression is a leading cause of suicide)

*"Have you made a plan to attempt suicide in the past twelve months?"* 18% answered YES or over 1 out of every 6 young people.
Compared to Nationally – 17.6%

*"Have you attempted suicide in the past twelve months?"* 10.2% answered YES or over 1 out of every 10 young people.

Compared to Nationally – 10.2%



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
